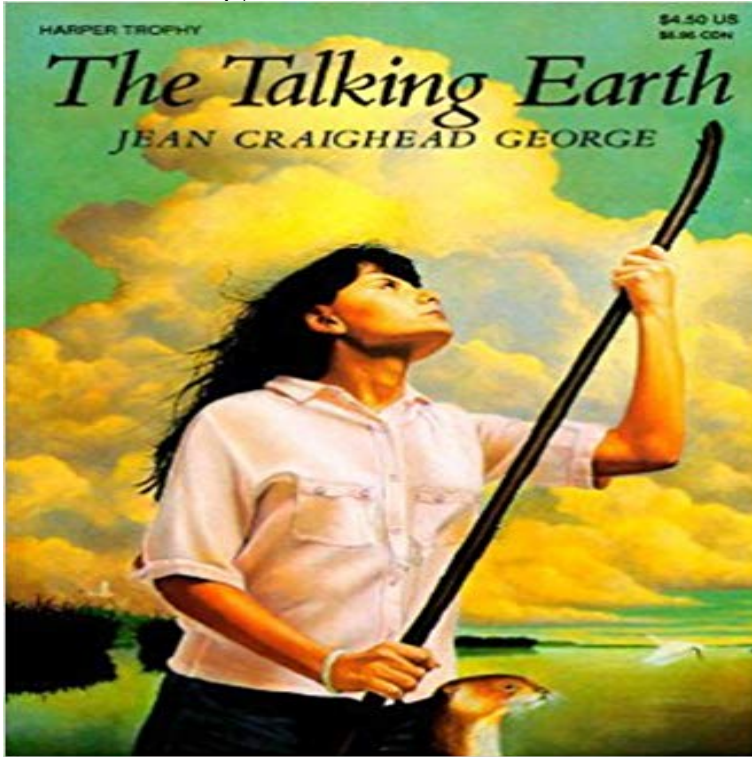


The Talking Earth
